

Our highest priority is the safety of all personnel – this includes our teams, our owners, and our subcontractors and suppliers. In order to promote and adhere to the new recommendations from governmental / health agencies such as the CDC, have implemented several changes immediately as a result of COVID-19.

To the extent possible, we are minimizing physical contact and maintaining a social distance of 6’.

If any of your employees on our projects is experiencing flu-like symptoms, they are to be removed from the project immediately, and contact their respective supervisor as well as the New South Project Superintendent. Further, if any individual on a project site tests positive for COVID-19, communicate the same immediately. That individual will need to leave the project site and will not be permitted back without medical clearance. Infected individuals will be asked to identify anyone that they had physical contact with in the previous 14 days.

As well, below are several general health and hygiene guidelines we are implementing throughout our company, and we strongly encourage you to do likewise:

1. Each day, preferably within two hours but no later than four hours after your shift start, the attached checklist must be completed by your site supervisor and turned in to the designated New South representative on site. If this is not done, your crews may be removed from the site immediately. This is a mandatory requirement from the Executive Order and is vital to the mitigation of the spread of COVID-19.
2. It is strongly encouraged that each subcontractor obtains at least one non-contact thermometer for each project.
3. Avoid all gatherings and continually maintain a social distance of 6’. This also includes break times, lunch time, and when otherwise resting.
4. Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly.
5. Cover your nose and mouth with your arm or sleeve when coughing or sneezing.
6. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
7. Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
8. Face coverings are a MANDATORY on the Emory University campus.
